#### **Traditional CSA**

Enjoy 14 weeks (full share) or 7 weeks (half share) of fresh seasonal produce, herbs and flowers from the farm.

- CSA members will pick up their share at the farm Saturdays 9am-1pm, June 22nd-September 21st. Half shares will be assigned to an A week or B week for pick up.
- Every share contains roughly 10-15 items which includes Pick your own when available
- CSA members will be able to choose what they would like to include in their weekly share from a variety of items set up similar to our farmers market stand
- Pick your own items, when in season, include flowers, herbs, cherry tomatoes, peas, beans and more
- Our policy for missed pickups: We know everyone will have at least one conflict during the season that prevents them from picking up during the designated time. Your first option is to send a friend, neighbor or relative to pick up in your place and we always encourage this. If you can't find anyone to pick up for you, please let us know *at the latest* by Saturdays at 12pm, we will pack up a "farmers choice" CSA share that you can pick up at the farm by the following Tuesday at 10am. After this point any unclaimed shares will be donated to local food pantries or soup kitchens through the Foodshed Alliance's Local Share program

- Because we incur almost all of our expenses for the season during the winter and early spring months, CSA Members are encouraged to pay by the Early Bird Deadline of April 1st and in full.
- We offer a significant Early Bird Discount on our Farm CSA shares if paid in full by April 1st.
- We recognize that not everyone can pay early and in full. If this is not an option for you, please send a \$100 deposit to reserve your share with the balance due by May 1st. We ask that you pay the balance by May 1<sup>st</sup> so we can focus on growing great produce for you rather than tracking payments. You are welcome to pay in installments up until that point.

I understand that the farmers choose crops and varieties to grow based on what they know, from years of experience, will thrive with the specific growing conditions at the farm. I further understand that I am signing up for a CSA share which reflects the seasonality of produce grown in Northern New Jersey-not all crops will be available all the time, rather they will be available according to seasonal growing limits. I understand that there will be no refunds and that by joining a CSA, I share in the risks and satisfaction of farming, including poor harvests due to weather or pests and bountiful harvests during favorable growing conditions."
